The geographical boundaries for emissions reporting cover the following locations and operational areas:

- Head Office and Regional Management Centres: The central administrative functions, leadership, and operational coordination are based at All Care Plus Limited's Head Office.
 Emissions arising from activities at this location, including energy use, waste management, water consumption, and staff commuting, are included within the reporting boundary.
- Service Delivery Network: All Care Plus Limited delivers personalised care services through its
 operational network. Each location's operational activities, such as local office energy usage
 and employee travel for care visits, contribute to the overall emissions footprint and are
 included within the geographical reporting boundary.
- Client Service Areas (Care Services): The organisation provides in-home care and support
 services to individuals within their own residences. Emissions associated with care worker
 travel, particularly for delivering services directly to clients' homes, form a significant part of
 the emissions scope and are included.
- Field-based Care Teams: All Care Plus Limited employs a network of mobile care workers who
 travel to deliver services. The emissions from these mobile operations, including travel and
 service delivery activities, are accounted for within the organisation's overall carbon reporting.

By clearly defining these geographical boundaries, All Care Plus Limited ensures a thorough and transparent approach to GHG emissions reporting across its operations. This methodology aligns with best practice environmental reporting standards, supporting the organisation's efforts to accurately



measure, manage, and reduce its carbon footprint in line with its commitment to sustainability and high-quality care delivery.



Figure 1 While we maintain relatively low operational emissions, All Care Plus recognises that Healthcare employee commuting represents a significant portion of our carbon footprint. We are committed to addressing this and pursuing continued improvement across all areas.

Over the coming years, we will actively seek to lower emissions, with a primary focus on reducing emissions associated with care team travel. This will involve:

- Exploring and promoting the use of lower-emission vehicles and transportation options among our care teams.
- Optimising scheduling and routing to minimise travel distances and times.
- Leveraging technology to facilitate remote care and reduce the need for in-person visits where appropriate, without compromising the quality of care.

Through this proactive approach, including the exploration of innovative solutions and ongoing assessments of our operational impacts, we aim to enhance our efficiency and sustainability, ensuring that our efforts consistently drive us toward a net-zero carbon footprint by 2040.




Current Emissions Reporting 1st Apr 2024 to 31st Mar 2025
